Information Required to Apply for a VA Pension

1. Proof of Service, DD-214 (WD AGO Form 53-55 for WWII Veterans.)
2. Veterans and spouses Social Security numbers, date of birth, and place of birth (city and state).
3. Information of any and all previous marriages for both Veteran and Spouse. Including date & place of marriage, date & place of divorce, and date & place of death if applicable.
4. Current marriage certificate.
5. Death Certificate if applicable (Survivor's Pension).

Financial Information Required

1. Social Security Income Statements for Veteran and Spouse.
2. Any Pension Income Statements (showing gross income.)
3. A current bank statement for all checking and savings accounts.
4. Any other income statements that pay a monthly or annual income.
5. Interest statements for any IRA's, Stocks, Bonds, or CD's. Generally a 1099R is issued for these once a year.
6. Any information showing any type of transfer of assets including the sale of residence or property.
7. Direct Deposit information (account number and routing number.)

Medical Expenses and Forms

1. Proof of cost for any Health Insurance or Supplemental Health Insurance where you pay a premium.
2. Any out of pocket co-pays for Doctor visits.
3. Monthly estimate for what you pay for over the counter items. I.E.: Depends, Ensure, Diabetes, etc. which may be necessary according to your physician.
4. Form 21-2680, filled out by attending physician, form 21-0779 if residing in a Nursing Home. Please fill out the Worksheet for an Assisted Living Facility and/or In Home Attendant form if applicable. If you check yes in any of the boxes on page 9 of the 21-534 EZ form, please fill out or provide documentation for the enclosed form 21P-0969.

Some of these items may not apply to the Veteran or the Spouse and are only listed to help prepare to file a claim for Pension.
